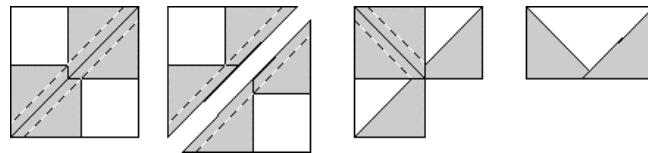


Zig-Zag Flag Quilt

60" X 84"

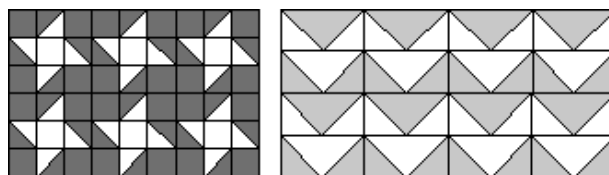
Cut the following:

| | (flying geese) | (32) 6 7/8" sqs. |
| | (stars) | (12) 4 7/8" sqs. |
| | | (6) 4 1/2" sqs. |
| reds - 2 1/2 yards | (flying geese) | (8) 13 1/4" sqs. |
| | (flying geese) | (32) 6 7/8" sqs. |
| blues - 1 1/2 yard | (star bkgnd.) | (12) 4 7/8" sqs. |
| | | (24) 4 1/2" sqs. |
| blue - 3/4 yard | (binding) | (8) 2" strips |



Piece the red and white flag rows following the diagrams below.

Make two of each.



Make three of each.

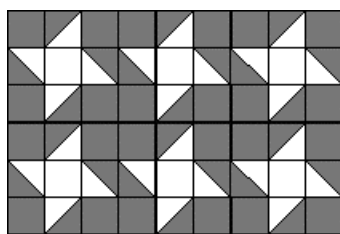
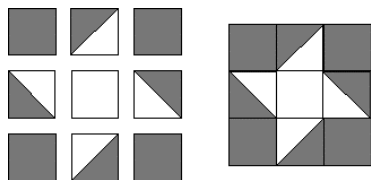


Half Square Triangles - Using the 4 7/8" light and blue squares, make twenty-four half square triangles.

- Place one light and one dark square right sides together.
- Mark through center of square diagonally, corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" away from drawn line on each side.
- Cut in half, press block flat and then press open toward the dark side. This method makes 2 half square triangles.



Piece the stars together following the directions below: Piece six stars.

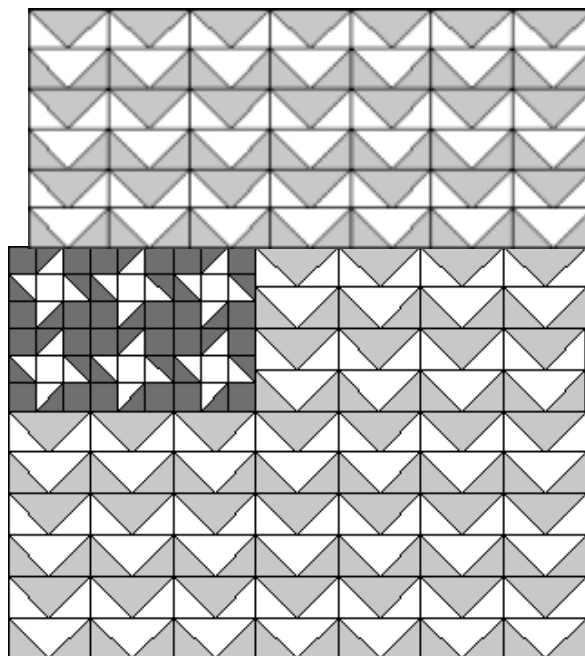


Piece the rows into the sections below.

Flying Geese: Make fifty-eight flying geese, twenty-nine with the red 7 1/4" squares and the light 6 7/8" squares and twenty-nine with the reverse colors. The method below makes four flying geese.

- Lay two small 6 7/8" diagonally on the 13 1/4" sqs. and mark a diagonal line through the center. Sew 1/4" seam on each side.
- Cut block through the center.
- Press small triangles away from larger. Lay a small triangle on the corner of each pressed half, mark and sew as above. Press as before.

Option - If you would like to add borders cut the following:
 inner border (8) 2" strips 1/2 yard
 outer border (9) 6" strips 1 5/8 yard

Sew the inner border strips together, end-to-end. Measure length of quilt and cut two 2 ½" strips this length. Sew a strip to each side. Measure quilt width and cut two 2 ½" strips this width. Sew one to the upper and lower edge of the quilt. Repeat these steps with the outer border.

To make a scrappy Giant ZigZag quilt use the following yardage

White stars - 1/2 yard OR (3) 5 1/2" strips
Lights (3) 15" strips AND (6) 8" strips
Reds (3) 15" strips AND (6) 8" strips
Blues (11) 5 1/2" strips OR 1 1/2 yards

Quilt Country donated the fabrics for the quilt and the local quilt guild did the sewing.
